

DEVELOPING CORPUS-BASED MATERIALS FOR TOURISM STUDENTS IN INDONESIA AND THAILAND

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ABSTRACT

This study aims at developing Corpus-based materials for cultural guiding technique instructions for tourism students in Indonesia and Thailand. The corpus has been developed by Widodo et al (2020) became the foundation of designing the materials. This study is a Research and Development (R&D) which will use the spiral model as recommended by Cennamo and Kalk (2005). In the spiral model there are 5 (five) known phases of development, namely: (1) define, (2) design, (3) demonstrate, (4) develop, and (5) deliver. The reason for using of R & D method in this study is to fill the gap of theoretical fundamental with a practical one. Products resulting from this research will be prototype materials for cultural guiding instruction. This study will be a collaboration of researchers of Universitas Negeri Yogyakarta, Indonesia and a partner researcher of Silpakom University, Thailand. As the second-year research, the data collection will involve FGD, observation, questionnaire distribution and expert judgements on the developed corpus-based teaching material for tourism guides.
