PETANQUE ARBITRE TRAINING FOR YOGYAKARTA SPECIAL REGION

ABSTRACT

Petangue is a boules game where the goal is to throw an iron ball as close as possible to the wooden ball and the feet are in a small circle. The human resources needed include athletes, coaches, and arbitrators. Arbite has a very important role in the implementation of petanque sports championships. Accuracy is required as an arbitrator in carrying out his duties to adjudicate wisely every problem. The importance of an arbiter in a petanque competition has not been matched by the number of arbiters owned by the Special Region of Yogyakarta. With this gap, the devotees have the idea of ??conducting "Training for Arbite Petangue at the Special Region of Yogyakarta". It is hoped that this arbitration training in the Special Region of Yogyakarta will be able to improve the quantity and quality of Petangue arbitration in Yogyakarta in particular and Indonesia in general. Considering the number of arbitrators owned by the Special Region of Yogyakarta is still very limited. Objectives: This community service activity (PkM) was held with the objectives of (1) To give birth to arbitrators in the Special Region of Yogyakarta and (2) improving the competence of arbitrators of the Special Region of Yogyakarta. Method: the implementation of community service is provided by conducting training by directly bringing in arbitrators who have been licensed and practicing directly in the field. Result: The series of S2 Institutional PPM activities carried out by the Faculty of Sports Science received good appreciation from the participants. Arbitration training activities will be held on Saturday and Sunday, 30 - 31 July 2022. On Saturday, 30 July 2022, the activity is in the form of providing material. And on July 31, 2022, the arbit petanque competency practice exam will be held. This activity was attended by 28 participants from several provinces, including (1) Central Java 6 participants, (2) East Java 3 participants, (3) DIY 18 participants, (4) West Kalimantan 1 participant. All participants can succeed and pass and are eligible to become regional-level arbitrators.
