Development of Short Film Media "Mortgage Together" for Prevention of Sexual Harassment in High School Students

ABSTRACT

In 2020 the Ministry of PPPA recorded 14,281 cases of sexual violence. Various efforts have been made to prevent sexual harassment, but the rate of sexual harassment is still high. This study aims to produce a short film "Gerak Bersama" that is appropriate and effective for preventing sexual harassment in high school students.

This research is a type of research and development (research and development). The subjects in this study were 6 guidance and counseling teachers in the small-scale trial and 13 in the large-scale trial and 122 high school students in Sleman Regency. This research resulted in three short films entitled "Speak Up!", "Enabler?", and "Relasi (Kuasa)" as well as a media manual. The research development model refers to the Borg & Gall procedure with 10 stages. The data collection method uses an attitude scale against sexual harassment. The feasibility assessment of short film media involved 3 media expert validators and 3 material expert validators. Data analysis techniques used descriptive statistics and used an experimental design with T-test and N-Gain analysis.

This research produced three short films with an average duration of 10-15 minutes and a media guide \book. Based on the assessment by media expert validators and material experts, short film media is considered feasible by giving a score in the "very feasible" category for short film media. The effectiveness test using the T-test resulted in an average value in the pretest of 121.72 and an average value in the postest of 152.96 and a sig. (2-tailed) is 0.000 < 0.05 which indicates if there is an average difference between the pretest and posttest. The N-Gain test result is 0.653 which is included in the medium category and the N-Gain value in percentage is 65% which is included in the moderately effective category. The short film "Gerak Bersama" was declared appropriate and effective in preventing sexual harassment in high school students.
