EXPLORATION STUDY OF USER SATISFACTION GRADUATES ON THE PERFORMANCE OF GRADUATES OF THE S2 SPORTS SCIENCE STUDY PROGRAM FIK UNY

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ABSTRACT

The capacity to behave, think, and act can reflect an individual's image in the perception of others, particularly in the workplace. **Method:** The research employed a quantitative descriptive methodology and a random sampling strategy. It was determined that 47 graduates were willing to willingly fill out the questionnaire, graduated from the Master of Sports Science program between 2014 and 2021, and followed all instructions when using the instrument. **Results:** Ethics (3.84 0.42), expertise (3.86 0.35), information technology (3.78 0.46), communication (3.78 0.42), cooperation (3.90 0.30), and self-development (3.82 0.39) were deemed to be good. Only foreign language skills (3.27 ± 0.69) still have an average below 3.5. **Conclusions:** team communication skills are frequently exercised in sports, there is little dispute about sports graduates' capacity to collaborate, yet there are still inadequacies in foreign language abilities. it is still deemed deficient.
