Perceptions of Yogyakarta State University Bachelor of Education Program Students Regarding the Implementation of Educational Practices in Schools

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ABSTRACT

Preparing prospective teachers for a career in education is a challenging task for teacher training programs. The teaching profession is becoming increasingly complex, the adaptability of teachers is being challenged permanently. Teachers are expected to have a wide range of competencies, both in areas of specialization and pedagogy.
