PKM FOR SEQUINS EMBROIDERY CRAFTSMAN IN SINDET VILLAGE, BANTUL THROUGH A WORKSHOP FOR MAKING TAMBOUR BEADING EMBROIDERY SIMPLE HELPED TOOLS

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ABSTRACT

Abstract

This community service activity aims to improve skills, creativity, innovation and produce sequin embroidery products for sequin craftsmen in Sindet Bantul village that are of high quality and marketable. The methods used include: (1) lecture and discussion methods to provide knowledge about creative and innovative thinking, knowledge of tambour tools and materials, tambour cutting techniques, product packaging, and digital marketing, (2) question and answer method to bridge if there is any unclear training participants, and (3) individual practice methods and mentoring with a simple tambour. During the training activity through making sequin embroidery with a simple tambour tool were 10 samples of sequin embroidery applied to fashion products. Based on the results of the evaluation and assessment by the PKM Team with the assessment criteria that have been relied on, 8 out of 10 participants are classified as good, meaning they are worth selling, and 2 out of 10 participants are classified as good enough. So it can be concluded that the product produced with the help of this simple tambour is suitable enough to be sold but the quality still needs to be improved.
