## TRANSFORMATIVE POLITICAL EDUCATION MODEL IN THE PROSPEROUS JUSTICE PARTY AND MUHAMMADIYAH BOARDING SCHOOL YOGYAKARTA

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## **ABSTRACT**

This research was conducted in an effort to find gaps of knowledge between normative ideals and reality in the implementation of political education in the Muhammadiyah Boarding School (MBS) and the Prosperous Justice Party (Partai Keadilan Sejahtera, PKS). By using network theory, it explains how the tarbiyah da'wah movement expands its base of social support through various activities where political education is an effort devoted to educational institutions that seek to form and grow a political personality that is in line with the political culture of every citizen. The specific purpose of this study is to explain the political education activities carried out by PKS and MBS to produce citizens who have nationalism and a vision of citizenship. The method used to achieve the objectives of this research is qualitative with case study research. Data collection techniques through interviews, observation and documentation. The validity of the data uses technical triangulation, namely selecting data from interviews. observations and documentation. Researchers collected data through interviews, observations and documentation studies then carried out data analysis and discussion. The results of the study show that 1) political education used by PKS is through door to door and delivered through religious studies and leadership seminars. This can be seen from the party cadre curriculum and political education which focuses on cadres as well as voters. However, the political education carried out has several weaknesses. 2) political education in MBS is carried out through cadre schools, producing intellectual and intellectual scholars, creating cadres of national leaders, making MBS a center of Islamic scholarship, and a center for moral development. 3) formulation of the concept of political education by combining general and religious curricula in a balanced way, teaching politics through the Muhammadiyah Student Association (Ikatan Pelajar Muhammadiyah, IPM).
