The Impact Of The COVID-19 Pandemic And Household Food Insecurity On Female Household Heads In Wonolelo Village, Sawangan District, Magelang Regency

ABSTRACT

This study examines the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and household food insecurity on female household heads in Wonolelo Village, Sawangan District, Magelang Regency. The purpose of the study was to analyze the impact of covid on households and household food insecurity with female household heads, to examine the efforts made by women to overcome the impact of covid 19 and food insecurity during the pandemic.

Research with a population of female heads of houses in Wonolelo Village, Sawangan District, Magelang Regency. The research combines quantitative using trend cross tables and frequency tables and Annova test to explain phenomena and qualitative with phenomenology approach.

The results are a study of the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and household food insecurity with a female household head in Wonolelo Village, Sawangan District, Magelang Regency, and the efforts made by women to overcome the impact of COVID-19 and food insecurity during the pandemic. The results showed that the age of and female head of the household was relatively young with low education. Sources of income for women with female household heads come from working as farmers and farm laborers with household income below the minimum wage in 2021. The linear regression test table for one independent variable can be seen that the value of Sig deviation from linearity > 0.05, it can be seen that the relationship between each independent variable (socio-economic status) to the dependent variable (food insecurity of female household heads during the COVID-19 pandemic) is linear. The results showed that there was no influence between socio-economic factors on food insecurity for female household heads in Wonolelo Village, Sawangan District, Magelang Regency during the covid 19 pandemic. Women's efforts to overcome food insecurity are looking for additional sources of income to obtain decent food, diversify food by growing food crops and process foodstuffs to be varied.
