

LEVELS OF ACHIEVEMENT OF SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS IN URBAN AND RURAL VILLAGES IN THE SPECIAL REGION OF YOGYAKARTA PROVINCE

ABSTRACT

The village fund allocation policy is one of the government's efforts to increase development at the village level with the spirit of decentralization. One of the current development goals at the village level is the Village Sustainable Development Goals, where the government is currently encouraging all villages through the Ministry of Villages, PDT and Transmigration to be able to achieve Village SDGs in stages. This study aims to describe a) the level of achievement of Village Sustainable Development Goals in DIY Province; b) a partnership model held between villages and village stakeholders in supporting the achievement of Village SDGs?; and c) obstacles in efforts to achieve the SDGs of the Village?. To fulfill the research objectives. This researcher uses a qualitative descriptive-explorative approach, in which the research has systematically analyzed the description of the facts and characteristics of the subjects and objects studied. The research was carried out from March to September 2022. The research location was carried out in the Special Province of Yogyakarta, in several villages selected by purposive sampling according to the characteristics determined by the researcher. Informants in this study are village heads or village officials who understand development in their area. Data was collected through interviews, observation and documentation, and then analyzed using an interactive model of a qualitative approach. The results of the study show that several villages that have received funds already have several supporting programs related to the SDGs program. The village's success in implementing the program is supported by several activities, one of which is the existence of many partners established by the village government. However, in the implementation of some of these programs there are also several obstacles including the emergence of different perspectives in achieving program objectives with stakeholders. So there needs to be an in-depth discussion effort to equalize perceptions.
