

The Implementation of the Good Governance General Principles in General Elections of South Kalimantan Regional Heads

ABSTRACT

This study aims to describe and analyse the implementation of good governance general principles in the general election of South Kalimantan Regional Heads. This general election was held in 2020 where its results were brought to the Constitutional Court as a judicial institution that resolve disputes over the general election results.

This study is included in the legal research with a case approach. Data were collected utilizing a documentation technique. The collected documents are documents related to the implementation of the South Kalimantan general election in 2020 and the Constitutional Court Judge's Decision document Number 124/PHP.GUB-XIX/2021 on ordering the South Kalimantan Provincial General Election Commission to conduct a Re-Election of the Governor and Deputy Governor of South Kalimantan Province in 2020 and the Decision of the Constitutional Court Judge Number 146/PHP.GUB-XIX/2021 which contains Rejecting the Plaintiff's Lawsuit.

The results show that (1) the implementation of good governance in the 2020 South Kalimantan General election has not been well performed by the election organizers; (2) there is a violation of good governance in the 2020 South Kalimantan regional head election which has been proven in the Constitutional Court trial. The main violated principles deal with the electoral implementation which are based on the following principles: direct, public, independent, confidential, honest, and fair; (3) the resolution of disputes on violations of good governance in the 2020 South Kalimantan General Election is based on the decision of the Constitutional Court to order election organizers in the South Kalimantan Province to hold re-elections in some areas in South Kalimantan in dispute; order South Kalimantan election commission to appoint the Chairman and members of election organizers as well as the new Chairman and Members of District Election Organizers in the area requested to hold the re-election; order the Central KPU to conduct supervision and coordination with the General Election Commission of the South Kalimantan Province and its ranks in implementing the decision of the Constitutional Court to carry out the re-election; and order the Supervisory Board of the Republic of Indonesia to conduct supervision and coordination with the Supervisory Board of the South Kalimantan Province and its ranks in implementing the decision of the Constitutional Court; and order the State Police of the Republic of Indonesia, especially the South Kalimantan Provincial Police and its ranks, to secure the re-voting process.
