## PRO POOR POLICY IN COMMUNITY-BASED DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION PROGRAM IN GUNUNGKIDUL DISTRICT

## **ABSTRACT**

This study aims to gain a comprehensive understanding of pro-poor policies in the Community-Based Water Supply and Sanitation Program in Gunungkidul Regency; and gain an understanding of the factors that hinder it. This study uses descriptive qualitative research methods. In this study, data were obtained through in-depth interviews with purposively determined sources. The resource persons in this study are related parties who understand and are involved in the PAMSIMNAS program in Gunungkidul Regency. In addition, data collection was also carried out through observation and documentation. The results show that the PAMSIMAS program has not yet been the embodiment of policies that are pro-poor because the targeting of the program has not specifically targeted the program recipients to the poor. However, in its implementation the Pamsimnas program has been able to increase public access to the availability of clean water from the period of program implementation to the implementation of the next program. In addition, various stakeholders have also shown their roles and participation in the implementation of the program. Although there are still some obstacles, such as the poor quality of water sources during the rainy season, and limited funds in program management. However, through this Pamsimas program, it can help the community in accessing water services at an affordable cost.
