Innovation in learning is needed to improve the quality of learning so that the learning process of students can be designed optimally. Innovation is developed and managed creatively so that it can implement various steps. One of the goals of learning innovation is to create a conducive learning process and atmosphere for students. It is hoped that when there is a learning innovation, it can increase students' interest in learning, improve the quality of learning, develop knowledge and insight and improve previous learning towards a better one. One of the steps that can be taken is to develop learning media based on local wisdom to be one of the breakthroughs. Therefore, this breakthrough inspired the UNY service team to be able to develop learning media based on local wisdom. According to the interview with the head of the Social Sciences MGMP, the learning media based on local wisdom, according to interviews with the head of the Social Sciences MGMP, it was revealed that most of the social studies subject teachers had not been able to maximize it. Most teachers are also lacking in supporting the use of innovative learning media, the learning process also does not apply aspects of social values ??and learning media is still conventional. In fact, if it becomes a shared awareness that local wisdom possessed by the Indonesian people in the form of noble values, it can be integrated into social studies learning through media development. On the other hand, if the teacher is able to generate local potential which has been considered marginalized from the public's attention, it will be good for the world of education.

The activity methods chosen for the implementation of community service activities for the development of local wisdom-based learning media for IPS MGMP teachers in Purbalingga Regency are: Lectures and Questions and Answers, Demonstration, Training and Tutorials, and Practice. Practical activities are activities that express the results of the tutorial in a real form, where participants are exposed to direct practice. Based on the results of the assessment of local wisdom-based learning media made by all PPM participants, the results were 65% in the very good category with a score above 81; 10% are in good category with scores between 61 to 80, 15% are categorized as good enough with scores from 41 to 60, while 10% are in poor category with scores from 21 to 40 and 0% are categorized as very poor with scores below 20. It can be concluded that participants PPM has understood the material presented by the Service Team. Based on the results of the PPM participant satisfaction questionnaire distributed by the Service Team as a form of evaluation of PPM activities, it was obtained that 85% were in the high category, 15% were in the moderately high category and 0% were in the low category. So it can be concluded that PPM participants have high satisfaction with the training activities of the service team from Social Studies Education in 2022.
