

SURVEY OF TRACER STUDY ON ELEMENTARY PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHER EDUCATION STUDY PROGRAM FIK UNY

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ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine: 1) a complete picture of the graduate job search period, 2). academic service quality, and 3). the relevance of the Physical Education PGSD study program curriculum to the needs of the job market.

This research is a descriptive research using survey method. The population of this research is the alumni of PGSD Penjas study program students who graduated from 2014-2019. The instrument used for this research is through an online questionnaire system that has been prepared by LPMPP UNY. This instrument is considered to have advantages, including more cost-effective (no need to print and send by post), does not require a lot of staff in its distribution (data is entered by the respondent into the system), the output will be faster (data is collected in the system so that processing is done faster), and it is likely that more respondents will be netted. Analysis of the data used in this study using quantitative descriptive analysis techniques that will describe the research data in the form of numbers, tables and percentages which are then interpreted as conclusions that can be drawn.

Based on the results of the study, it can be concluded that the tracer results of PGSD Penjas student alumni have been documented from 2014 to 2019. It can also be concluded that the documented data from students includes the source of study funds, the time to start looking for work and get a job, as well as the competencies possessed based on on the material components of the related study program curriculum. The quantitative results obtained that the curriculum components can be said to support the achievement of alumni competencies.
