QUALITY OF RESULTS OF FINAL PROJECT RESEARCH STUDENTS OF FINE ARTS EDUCATION STUDY PROGRAM, FACULTY OF LANGUAGE AND ART, STATE UNIVERSITY OF YOGYAKARTA

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ABSTRACT

Student Thesis Final Project (TAS) is one component of the curriculum that plays an important role in achieving the competencies of graduates of the Fine Arts Education undergraduate program. Therefore, it is necessary to analyze the results of student TAS research in order to obtain an overview of the direction and quality of student TAS as a reference for evaluating the implementation of TAS in the Fine Arts Education S1 study program. This study attempts to analyze 1) the extent to which the TAS results of the students of the Fine Arts Education Study Program, FBS, UNY are relevant to the object of research in fine arts education, 2) the extent to which the quality of student TAS results in terms of themes, content structure, and research methods. The research design used is descriptive normative research, with a library research approach where the research results are compared with certain norms. The population of this research is all the final thesis work in the study program in the last three years. Of the 109 TAS results of the students of the Fine Arts Education Study Program, FBS UNY from 2019-2022, only 31% studied the theme of education. Student TAS results are dominated by the use of research and development methods (48.6%) with themes focusing on Visual Communication Design (DKV) (26.6%), painting (17.4%), illustrations (9.17%)) and the rest varies on the themes of interior design, craft, graphic, sculpture, animation, ornament, photography and 2-dimensional art. Of the 20 TAS which were analyzed in depth, it was found that the average student TAS results achieved a quality score of 82% or 26.95 of the 33 quality indicators used as measurement criteria. 21 quality indicators were achieved by 90-100% of TAS results, which showed that in general the quality of TAS results for students of the Fine Arts Education Study Program, FBS, UNY was very good. However, the aspects of originality and sharpness of the state of the art produced through discussion of the latest references still need to be improved.
