## ASSISTANCE IN THE ORGANIZATION OF SIMILAR PRESCHOOL UNITS AT KINABALU MALAYSIA'S COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER (CLC)

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## ABSTRACT

The government is paying attention by providing educational services to all citizens, including migrant workers in Kinabalu. There are 100 Community Learning Centers in Kinabalu, according to data from the Indonesian Embassy, and nearly all of them offer non-formal PAUD programs. Non-formal PAUD provides simulation services to TKI children. According to available data, the number of non-formal PAUD educators remains limited, both in terms of qualifications and competence. Non-formal PAUD educators in Kinabalu, Malaysia, receive International Community Service in the form of training and mentoring. This PkM's outputs include social media and article publications, as well as collaboration with university partners, the Indonesian Embassy in Kinabalu, and the Indonesian Kinabalu School, which covers CLC.
